- Tuesday 5 June 2007 picket / vigil outside US Consulate in Jhb from 1630 to 1930. Night time candle picket from 1900 to 1930. Everybody is urged to join this by lighting a candle and standing in line from 1900 to 1930. Candles and posters will be provided at the venue
- Wednesday 6 June 2007 Parliamentary activities
- Thursday 7 June 2007 university action, WITS & UCT and other institutions throughout the country. Due to exams, just one hour of unified action will demonstrate that South African students says NO to the occupation
- Friday 8 June 2007 pickets around the country from 14:00 to 15:00 at selected stores that stock Israeli products
- Saturday 9 June 2007 mass action in Cape Town, Johannesburg, Durban and Pretoria Marches are to be held in Cape Town from 10h00 to 12h00 and Durban and a rally in Johannesburg from 15h00 to 18h00 at the City Hall. In Pretoria a peaceful demonstration outside the Israeli Embassy 0900 to 1100, including the breaking down of a mock up ‘Apartheid Wall’
